## Dorchester Veterans' Book of Remembrance

Residents throughout Dorchester and surrounding area have a unique opportunity to enrich and discover a part of their past with their newest local book "Dorchester Veterans' - Book of Remembrance". This is a special book was developed to celebrate and pay tribute to local veterans.

The Dorchester Community Access Center became interested in a project of this magnitude as a result of a presentation by the Doaktown Access Center at the annual conference and by researching a local book written by author, Douglas How, "One Village, One War". In October of 2005 student assistant, Melissa Trenholm, began researching and conducting interviews. This project became a great interest and passion and continues on after its first edition sold out. Revisions and additions are currently being compiled so that a second edition will be printed in the near future.

This special project is a tribute to Dorchester Veterans of World War I, World War II, the Korean War and the Vietnam War. The book consists of veterans who were born and raised in Dorchester, or who settled here after the war. Veterans, family members and relatives were interviewed for information such as where they served; their unit and rank; pictures and recollections or short stories of the war to make an interesting read.

The community of Dorchester, friends and relatives have been very supportive in assisting with the gathering of information for this project and helped contribute to the success of the book.
